

UCCI COURSE M E N T O R PROGRAM



What It Is:

The UCCI Course Mentor Program provides sustained ongoing support (throughout one full academic year) for educators who are new to teaching UCCI courses.

How It Works:

UCCI staff match a qualified educator who has been teaching a UCCI course with a teacher who is new to teaching that same course. The mentor:

1. Guides and supports the mentee through the experience of teaching complex new material and content.
2. Shares course lesson plans, pacing guides, rubrics, and other resources in order to help the mentee be successful.
3. May review lesson plans or activities as needed at the request of the mentee.

- ★ are currently teaching a UCCI course, and have done so for at least a full year.
